**The Purpose of Tigers Youth Football is:**

The primary purpose and intention of Tigers Youth Football (TYF) is to create an enjoyable football & cheerleading environment for the youth of our community. The rules, regulations and guidelines set forth are designed to insure equal participation, a healthy physical and moral development, appreciation for teamwork and a basis for learning the fundamentals of football

**Tigers Youth Football League Code of Conduct**

I hereby pledge to support the purposes stated above. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support and respect for all Participants, Coaches, Officials (and their calls during the games), Board Members, Staff and Opposing Teams at all times. I will, along with any guest of mine, refrain from any negative, threatening, vulgar, inappropriate or crude language/behavior while participating in, or watching any league sponsored event/practice. As per league rules, I, along with any guest of mine, will sit in bleachers or stands at games or practices. If I prefer to sit/stand near the field, I will stand behind the barrier rope.

I will acquaint myself with league rules as published on the Tigers Youth Football website ([www.uefootball.org](http://www.uefootball.org)) and agree to abide by and support these rules. I will direct all my comments and criticisms to board members and conduct myself in a calm, civilized manner when doing so. I understand that the Endicott Youth Football League will not tolerate abuse of this code of conduct. I understand that if this code is violated, the league shall have the authority to impose penalties that may include elimination of my participation in league activities even to the extent of not allowing me to be a spectator. I or my child may also be banned from league participation for up to 3 years depending upon the severity of the infraction.

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**Note: All parents, guardians, participants & coaches must sign this form prior to the start of individual team practices. Signed forms are to be given to the head coach for each team, who will maintain them on file. If code is not agreed to and this form not signed, participation in the league will not be allowed.**

**Infractions that may warrant a one game suspension:**

- Receiving a personal, or flagrant foul during a game for unsportsmanlike conduct
- Not complying with request of game personnel

**Infractions that may warrant a two game suspension:**

- Using obscene language or displaying flagrant gestures or other unsportsmanlike conduct
- Ejection from a game for inappropriate conduct
- Ejection of a participant from a game for rules violations
- Failure to play all participants their required playing time
- Use of tobacco by a coach, participant, or game personnel during a scheduled game or practice

**Infractions that may warrant a year long suspension:**

- Verbal threats or harassment made by a player, spectator or game personnel proceeding, during or following a game
- Providing false registration information about a participant which makes them eligible to participate in TYF



**Infractions that may warrant possible lifetime suspensions:**

- Physical violence towards a player, coach, spectator, scorekeeper or official proceeding, during or following a game
- Bringing a firearm or weapon into any Village facility or park by someone who is not a law enforcement officer
- Being under the influence of drugs or alcohol
